Students can enter the program with a master's degree or with previous graduate credits. Although we do not allow them to transfer credits into our doctoral program, they can petition to waive courses if they have taken those courses that meet the following conditions: 1) The prior course is deemed as equivalent to our course (to be waived) by the lead course instructor at KU; 2) The course must have been taken from an accredited school in a regularly scheduled course; 3) A grade of A or B must have been earned in the prior course; 4) Our "elective coursework" cannot be satisfied via waiver; and 5) No practicum coursework will be waived.
