

Information for Educational Psychology Students Seeking Travel Funding Support

Below is a list of funding sources to apply for graduate student travel. Note that these sources may or may not have funds available during the time of your application submission and/or travel. This is for information purposes only.

Educational Psychology

Maximum \$200/student, per academic year

Funding varies from year to year and it is anticipated that funding up to \$200.00 (once per academic year) may be available. First priority will be given to doctoral students but master's students are encouraged to apply.

School of Education

Maximum \$650/student, per academic year

Undergraduate and Graduate students in the School of Education are encouraged to apply for support that will allow them to travel to degree-relevant professional conferences/meetings, as well as to conduct degree-related research. Each initiative is intended to enhance the graduate students' professional preparation. Except under special circumstances, a student may receive only one travel award and one research support award per academic year. An individual student's combined travel (\$400 max.) and research support (\$250 max.) may not exceed \$650 for an academic year.

Graduate Studies: Graduate Scholarly Presentation Fund

Maximum \$500/Lawrence campus student, per length of time for degree

The Graduate Scholarly Presentation Travel Fund is available to Lawrence campus graduate students only. Eligible recipients must be presenting a paper or the disciplinary equivalent at a national or regional meeting of a learned or professional society. A student may receive an award (\$500) only once, and funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
